Headteacher's Update

Dear Parents/Carers

The final term of the school year is flying by and there are a lot of exciting things happening in the last few weeks, including trips out of school and transition activities. The Year 6 children will be having their visits to secondary school in the coming weeks and this week we welcomed our new Reception starters for the first of their taster sessions. Our Sports Days have been a great success and only one event moved due to the weather – which is unusual in Buxton! Thank you to parents/carers for supporting the Sports Days and other events in school.

Transition Week - 'This is Me'

The week commencing 9th July will be Transition Week and this year's theme is 'This is Me'. Your child will get to meet their new teacher in Transition Week and will spend the Monday and Friday mornings in their new classes, and the whole day on the Wednesday. They will take part in a range of activities to celebrate what makes them special and unique, for example painting portraits and sharing their hobbies, interests and talents. We will also be celebrating families and heritage. This will provide the opportunity for children to share things about themselves with their friends and new teacher. In preparation for this week, all children from Reception to Year 5 are asked to bring something in to celebrate their family/themselves. This could be:

- Photos or pictures about their family
- Family tree
- A piece of writing about their hobbies and interests
- A poster of what makes them special
- A fact file about themselves
- A favourite object to share

Items will need to be brought to school on Monday 9th July. As in previous years, the Wednesday will be a non-uniform day. In keeping with the theme of 'This is Me', children can come to school in clothes of their choice. For example, they can wear non-uniform; they may belong to a sports club and would like to wear their sports kit, Rainbow/Brownie/Scout uniform, dress as a book character, favourite football top, t-shirt or fancy dress.

Anti-Stigma Awareness and Wellbeing Campaign

As you may be aware, we are proud to be part of the Anti-Stigma Campaign, which is all about promoting mental health and wellbeing. Our three Year 6 Anti-Stigma Ambassadors will be running activities with different classes during our 'This is Me' Week.

Churches Fundraiser

I am sure you have heard about the burglary and vandalism at St James' Church and the Methodist Chapel last month. A number of children and staff have suggested we raise some funds in support of the Chapel and Church; therefore, on the Wednesday 11th July, during 'This is Me' week, children may bring in a voluntary donation to show their support of our wider community.

Mobile App Update

Thank you to everyone who has downloaded the school's app. We would like to encourage parents/carers to use this app as it is another way of keeping you informed about the life of the school and we hope that you will find it useful. We will be communicating with you using the following options in the app:

- School diary (Calendar)
- News
- Newsletters (also includes year group letters)
- Notices

The other menu options include:

- Links to other sites (e.g. the school website and Facebook page)
- Contact details for school
- Settings

In **Settings**, you will be able to set **push notifications** for **newsletters**, **news** and **notices**. We suggest that you limit these to your child's year group (select all those that apply if you have more than one child in school). If you want to, you can also synch your phone calendar with the school diary/calendar (this is **optional** and you will still be able to view the diary/calendar within the app if you choose not to sync it).

The download details can be found below:

Android users

Go to Google Play, search for **School Jotter** or scan the QR code.





iOS users

Go to App Store and search for **School Jotter** or scan the QR code.





Once the App has been installed, type in Harpur Hill (or our postcode SK17 9LP) to find our school (there is a large list in the Jotter App). You will then be asked whether or not you want the App to use push notifications. We suggest that these are set to on if you want to be kept updated as soon as new communication is sent. You can of course, always set these up later from within your phone settings.

Bikes & scooters
