Communication

Curriculum Events

Julie is carrying out the same role in Burbage Primary and Buxton Juniors, working one day in each school. She has also worked with the Buxton Multi Agency Team and has supported many Harpur Hill and Buxton families.

The school looked smart and tidy when the children returned. Over the summer holiday, the infant and lower junior toilets have been refurbished.

Nursery Places

The school nursery caters for children aged 3-4 and rising threes (children can start during the term in which they will have their third birthday). Sessions are from 9am until 12 noon, and 12.30pm until 3.30pm. Children can use their 15 hours 'universal' with us, as well as the full 30 hours for those eligible. 'Playdays' are able to provide Breakfast and After School provision for nursery children from 7.30am until 9am, and 3.30 until 6pm. Administration

Attendance

During the last academic year, our school attendance was 96.69%. The national figure for primary schools is 96%.

The Headteachers of COBRAS (Collaboration of Buxton and Rural Area Primary Schools) have agreed a joint approach to term-time absence for holidays during term time.

As you are aware, at Harpur Hill we stress the importance of good attendance and we have to follow the Local Authority procedures and guidance from Derbyshire County Council about the issue of penalty notices for unauthorised leave for the purpose of a family holiday.

If you request a holiday during term-time, schools have no choice but to mark it as unauthorised absence, unless there are exceptional circumstances, and you may be issued with a penalty notice. Schools do not benefit at all from any monies received from penalty notices as these are issued by the local authority.

We also believe that transparency is vital for home-school relationships so would encourage all parents to make a formal request if you are intending to take a term-time holiday or leave of absence.

If you are in any doubt about whether you would receive authorised leave of absence, please do not hesitate to phone or pop in to discuss your personal circumstances. Each request will be considered on a case by case basis. Thank you for your continued support.

Ukulele Club

Miss Howe, music teacher and owner of Little Music Monsters will be starting a club for any KS2 children who are interested in learning how to play this instrument. The first lesson will be for 5 weeks commencing on Friday 20th September from 3.30pm – 4.00pm. The cost for the 5 lessons will be £22.50. Mobile App

At present we have 244 people using the app, below is information about our mobile app which you can download and use on your mobile phone or tablet. The app will be another way of keeping you informed about the life of the school and we hope that you will find it useful. We will be communicating with you using the following options in the app:

- * School diary (Calendar)
- * News
- Newsletters (also includes year group letters)
- * Notices

The other menu options include:

- * Links to other sites (e.g. the school website and Facebook page)
- Contact details for school
- * Settings

In Settings, you will be able to set push notifications for newsletters, news and notices. We suggest that you limit these to your child's year group (select all those that apply if you have more than one child in school). If you want to, you can also synch your phone calendar with the school diary/calendar (this is optional and you will still be able to view the diary/calendar within the app if you choose not to synch it).

Android users

Go to Google Play, search for School Jotter or scan the QR code.





iOS users

Go to App Store and search for School Jotter or scan the QR code.





Once the App has been installed, type in Harpur Hill (or our postcode SK17 9LP) to find our school (there is a large list in the Jotter App). You will then be asked whether or not you want the App to use push notifications. We suggest that these are set to on if you want to be kept updated as soon as new communication is sent. You can of course, always set these up later from within your phone settings. Please download and use the new app; it will provide regular and useful communication from school.
